



## Volunteer information

We're happy to say that the Kinettes have developed a very efficient system to assemble a large number of hampers in a small space in a short amount of time! As such, we are unable to accommodate large numbers of volunteers looking to help with hamper assembly once donations come in.

How our process works:

- The food portion of the hampers will be completed on the Monday and Tuesday (Dec 12/13). All items are donated on the Monday, organized, and then hamper assembly begins. During this first day, we WILL run out of food and will do an inventory of remaining food. An order will be put in for the needed food and once it is filled we can continue assembling hampers.
- Tuesday we will finish assembling the hampers.
- Wednesday morning we have a large group of local school division staff come in to match family profiles with donated gifts.
- Thursday the Kinettes work to tie up loose ends and organize things for hamper pick up
- Friday- hamper pick up by recipients
